

Rocky Road DRIVING SCHEDULE CONFIRMATION INFORMATION

Plan on meeting your instructor in the area specified below the school you chose for pick up and drop off location, at the designated schedule time for each drive. For all other schools or locations not listed, you will be notified of meeting place details by email, phone or text message prior to your first scheduled drive.

ROCKY MOUNTAIN HIGH SCHOOL:

In the front of the school facing Linder near the flagpole

MOUNTAIN VIEW HIGH SCHOOL:

In the student parking lot located at the N.E. corner of Millennium and Puffin

MERIDIAN HIGH SCHOOL:

In the N.W. student parking lot located in front of the CTE Building near the Band Trailer

CENTENNIAL HIGH SCHOOL:

In the student parking lot at the front of the school facing McMillan near the flagpole

A parent or guardian will be required to ride along during the last hour of the final drive, so please factor this process into your schedule.

In the meantime, **continue to complete the 6 hours of observation required on your OUTSIDE OBSERVATION LOG** which will be given to your instructor by the last day of driving in exchange for your permit.

***CANCELLATION POLICY:**

Obviously if your student is feeling any flu like symptoms before their scheduled drive, please plan on communicating with us to reschedule. Any missed drive time without 24-hour prior notice will result in a cancellation fee of **\$25 per hour**, payable to the instructor, at the time services are rendered for the make-up drive(s).

****HEALTH & SAFETY PROCEDURES POLICY:**

Our instructors will be wiping down the vehicle interior after each student for proper sanitation. **If requested by a Parent/Guardian or Student**, instructors will wear a face mask or shield, *with the exception of any instructor listed with a *NO MASKS notation next to their name on the signup (due to approved medical reasons)*. Students will be expected to comply with any parent or instructor request for mask use, as well as provide their own mask.

*****WINTER WEATHER DRIVING POLICY:**

When snow is in the forecast, we will assess the situation on a case-by-case basis in the hours leading up to scheduled drives. If we are able to safely navigate the roads and teach students how to handle the conditions, we usually try to get the driving in. At any point during the day leading up to the drives, we can come to an agreement that the roads aren't safe for the experience and choose to reschedule. It really is a wait and see concept, especially since Idaho weather is known for its rapid and sometimes unpredictable changes, as it can snow 4 inches in the morning and be sunny and clear by 3pm. We'll do our best to give everyone ample notice as more information becomes available closer to the scheduled driving times. Thank you for trusting us to make the best decision based on the safety and well-being of all our students and instructors. We appreciate your understanding as we navigate the winter days we may experience.
